This year was a year of success for our students leaving Year 11, our English results were some of the best ever!

As you can see from the tables below, pupils at Sandwell Community School generally performed above the national expectation (taken from 2014-15 Dfe results release) for students attending an alternative provision school.

Other notable statistics for our Y11's success last year are:

- 74% of students left SCS with a qualification in Maths
- 39% of students left with a GCSE in Maths A*-G grade
- 85% of students left SCS with a qualification in English
- 59% of students left SCS with a GCSE in English A*- G

The table below shows the distribution of grades that pupils achieved both at SCS and also nationally (from 2014-15, the figures in brackets) at the end of KS4.
